

## PANTHERS BATHURST | Terms & Conditions: **Drop the Ball**

### Conditions of Entry

1. The promotion is conducted by the Panthers Bathurst under Penrith Rugby League Club Limited (ABN 57 000 578 398) 132 Piper Street Bathurst NSW 2795. Telephone number (02) 6330 0600.
1. The promotion operates from Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2018 through to Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2019
2. Promotion is open to current financial members, life members and permanent members and excludes Directors, Management, Staff, contractors and their employees of the Club and related companies.
3. The promotion comprises of (i) Drop the Ball Draws (ii) Jackpot Draw (iii) Clearance Jackpot Draw
4. Draws are held at the Panthers Bathurst premises (132 Piper Street Bathurst NSW 2795) and communicated each Sunday at 5pm. Member's must be present to claim their prize.
5. It is the responsibility of members to be in an area of the Panthers Bathurst premises where they can hear draw announcements.
6. A member must personally present their current financial membership card to the promotion host within four (4) minutes of the announcement to claim any prize.

### Entry to draws

1. Members will receive an entry ticket by making a purchase of \$10 or more in one of our participating locations (Players Bar, Raffle Station or Bistro). Three (3) tickets maximum per member per draw (one ticket in each area).
2. Members must present their club membership card to the clerk at the time of purchase to be swiped through the POS system. On doing this, the till will issue an entry ticket.
3. Entry tickets are to be placed into the corresponding marked entry barrel.
4. It is the responsibility of the member to have their entry ticket into the barrel before the barrel closes for each draw.
5. In the event of till malfunction, a receipt with the member's name, member number and staff signature will be issued as a barrel entry.

### (i) Drop the Ball Draws

Prize: 5 x \$50 and 1 x \$250:

1. At 5pm five draws will be conducted.
2. When a winner is drawn they need to present themselves and their current (financial) Panthers membership card.
3. They will win \$50 cash and will be asked to play 'Drop the Ball'
4. 'Drop the Ball' game consists of a Perspex peg box in which the player drops six (6) ping pong balls into. At the bottom of the box there are score slots. The total score is added up from the six balls.
5. Each score will be recorded on the score board and at the conclusion of the draws the highest score will win a \$250 cash.

### (ii) Jackpot Draw

Prize: 1 x Jackpot starting at \$1,000, jackpot by \$500 per week if not won up to \$10,000:

1. A jackpot of \$1000 is also available to be won.
2. To be eligible to win this jackpot a 'Drop the Ball' player has to achieve a total score of 50 points or more.
3. If the jackpot is not won it will increase by \$500 each week until won.
4. The winner of the jackpot can receive up to \$2,000 in cash and the remainder in a crossed cheque made out in their name totalling the overall jackpot amount.
5. If the jackpot reaches \$10,000, the clearance draw will take place.

### (iii) Clearance Jackpot Draw

Prize: 1 x \$10,000 and 10 x \$50:

1. If the jackpot reaches \$10,000 a clearance draw will take place whereby ten (10) winners will be drawn.
2. When a winner is drawn they need to present themselves and their current (financial) Panthers membership card.
3. They will win \$50 cash and asked to play 'Drop the Ball'
4. 'Drop the Ball' game consists of a Perspex peg box in which the player drops six (6) ping pong balls into. At the bottom of the box there are score slots. The total score is added up from the six balls.
5. Each score will be recorded on the score board and at the conclusion of the draws the highest score will win the \$10,000 jackpot.
6. The winner of the jackpot can receive up to \$2,000 in cash and the remainder in a crossed cheque made out in their name totalling \$10,000.

### General

1. Total prize value for the period of the promotion is up to \$48,000.
2. An independent scrutineer will be present as the draw value exceeds \$10,000.
3. The Club collects personal information in order to conduct the Promotion and may, for this purpose, disclose such information to third parties, including but not limited to agents, contractors, service providers, prize suppliers and, as required, to Australian regulatory authorities. Entry is conditional on providing this information. Entrants should direct any request to access, update or correct information to the Club. All entries become the property of the Club.
4. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the Club reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.
5. If this promotion is interfered with in any way or is not capable of being conducted as reasonably anticipated due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Club, the Club reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to the fullest extent permitted by law (a) to disqualify any entrant; or (b) subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority, to modify, suspend, terminate or cancel the promotion, as appropriate.
6. Except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law, the Club (including its officers, employees and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence), for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity); whether direct, indirect, special or consequential, arising in any way out of the Promotion, including, but not limited to, where arising out of the following: (a) any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Club's control); (b) any theft, unauthorized access or third party interference; (c) any entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Club) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Club; (d) any variation in prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions; (e) any tax liability incurred by a winner or entrant; or (f) use of a prize.
7. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
8. Entry is open to New South Wales residents aged 18 years or over who are fully financial members of the Club including proposed members and excluding barred/suspended, Directors, management and employees of the Club and its related companies and its marketing agencies are not eligible to participate in the Promotion and shall be ineligible for any prize covered herein. Entrants acknowledge that the Club is not liable for reimbursement of any prizes otherwise payable to eligible entrants who are in violation of this provision.

The Club reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant's identity, age, membership status and place of residence) and to disqualify any entrant whose entry is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or who tampers with the entry process. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Club's discretion. Failure by the Club to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
